Parent Code of Conduct

Preamble

The essential elements of character building and ethics in sports are embodied in the concept of sportsmanship and six core principles: TRUSTWORTHINESS, RESPECT, RESPONSIBILITY, FAIRNESS, CARING, AND GOOD CITIZENSHIP. The highest is achieved when competition reflects the six pillars of character.

I THEREFORE AGREE:

- 1-1 will not force my child to participate in sports.
- 2-1 will remember that children participate to have fun and that the game is for youth, not adults.
- 3-1 will inform the coach of any physical disability or ailment that may affect the safety of my child or the safety of others.
- 4-1 will learn the rules of the game and the policies of the league.
- 5-1 (and my guest) will not engage in any kind of unsportsmanlike conduct with any official, coach, player, or parent such as booing and taunting: refusing to shake hands: or using profane language or gestures.
- 6-1 (and my guest) will be a positive role model for my child and encourage sportsmanship by showing respect and courtesy, and by demonstrating support for all players, coaches, officials and spectators at every game, practice or any other sporting event,
- 7-1 will not encourage any behaviors or practices that would endanger the health and wellbeing of the athletes.
- 8-1 will teach my child to play by the rules and to resolve conflicts without resorting to hostility or violence.
- 9-1 will demand that my child treat other players, coaches, officials and spectators with respect regardless of race, color, sex or ability.
- 10-1 will teach my child doing one's best is more important than winning, so that my child will never feel defeated by the outcome of a game or his/her performance.
- 11-1 will praise my child for competing fairly and trying hard, and make my child feel like a winner every time.
- 12-1 will never ridicule or yell at my child or other participant for making a mistake or losing a competition.
- 13-1 will emphasize skill development and practices on how they benefit my child over winning. I will also deemphasize games and competition in the lower age groups.
- 14-1 will promote the emotional and physical well-being of the athletes ahead of my personal desire I may have for my child to win.
- 15-1 will respect the officials and their authority during games and will never question, discuss, or confront coaches at the game field, and will take time to speak with coaches at an agreed upon time and place.
- 16-1 will demand a sports environment for my child that is free from drugs, tobacco, and alcohol and I will refrain from the use at all sports events.
- 17-1 will refrain from coaching my child or other players during games and practices, unless I am one of the official coaches of them.

- I also agree that if I fail to abide by the aforementioned rules and guidelines, I will be subject to disciplinary action that could include, but not limited to the following:
- A- Verbal warning by the attending person in charge(Director, Athletic Coordinator, or Park Supervisor on duty)
- B- Written warning
- C- Parental game suspension with written documentation of incident kept on file by the organizations involved
- D- Parental season suspension
