

TOWN OF ERWIN

Inactive Residence Account Application

The Town of Erwin requires all residential dwellings to be supplied with approved trash containers for the disposal of such garbage and refuse that is or may be generated at such dwellings. The only approved trash containers are those provided by the Town or by the Town's solid waste service provider. Residential dwellings do or may generate standard household waste that is accepted by the Town's solid waste services for disposal at the County Landfill. Residential dwellings do or may generate additional disposable waste that is otherwise prohibited from being disposed at the County Landfill (these are recyclable materials). Therefore, each residential dwelling is required to have a standard household waste container provided by the Town and standard recyclable waste container provided by the Town's solid waste service provider.

The Town recognizes that not all residential dwellings within the Town are currently occupied and therefore may not generate such waste as a result of inactivity. The Town desires to afford such property owners of inactive residential dwellings the opportunity to have such containers removed from such inactive properties and the cost of the same reduced from the monthly water/sewer bill for such inactive properties. Approval of this application will remove the charges of household waste curbside and curbside recycling services, but will not remove the white good, brown good, and yard waste collection service charges.

This application serves to provide such information that will enable the Town to make determination of the status of such dwellings with respect to the dwellings' active or inactive state. In order to qualify for inactive status, the residential dwelling in question shall apply to Harnett County Public Utilities to have the water turned off at the meter at the subject residence thereby generating only the minimum charge for water/sewer (also known as the availability/convenience fee). At such time that the water/sewer service has been discontinued by way of having the water turned off at the meter for the subject residential dwelling, the property owner may submit the following application for review and determination by the Town of Erwin. At such time that the utilities are reactivated at the subject property, the trash containers and associated charges will be reactivated as well.
