All-Star Selection Policy

1. Head Coach Selection
 - a. The All-Star Head Coach will be the head coach that obtained the best record in Erwin vs. Erwin games during the regular season. The tiebreaker is as follows:
 - 1) Head-to-head
 - 2) Overall record
 - 3) Three-way coin toss
 - (i) Two-way tie: both coaches and a representative from EPR. Odd coach IN.
 - (ii) Three-way tie: all tied coaches. Odd coach IN.
 - b. In the event that there are only 2 teams from Erwin in a division that play each other only once during the regular season, items 1.a.1 and 1.a.2 will be reversed to prevent the determination of an All-Star Head Coach from hinging on a single game.
2. Assistant Coach Selection
 - a. One assistant coach from the All-Star Head Coach's regular season team will have the first opportunity to be an All-Star Assistant Coach. The recommendation must come from the All-Star Head Coach.
 - b. Regular season head coaches that are not the Head Coach for All-Star play will have the next opportunity to be an All-Star Assistant Coach in the order their teams finished the regular season among Erwin teams.
 - c. Regular season assistant coaches not selected in 2.a. will have the next opportunity to fill any remaining All-Star Assistant Coach positions.
 - d. If any All-Star Assistant Coach slots remain after Sections 2.a.-c., those slots will be made available to all other regular season assistant coaches and will be decided on by the All-Star Head Coach and a representative from EPR.
 - e. The number of All-Star Assistant Coaches is determined by each tournament.
3. Any coaches ejected from a game during the season may be disqualified from consideration as an All-Star Coach. Each situation will be handled on a case-by-case basis.
4. Player Selection
 - a. Each league head coach will vote by secret ballot for players in his/her division only.
 - b. Ballots: Basketball – up to 15 players Baseball/Softball – up to 20 players
 - c. Votes should be listed in ranking order (1 = best, 2 = second best, 3 = third best, etc.).
 - d. Votes will be weighted by number of votes received and vote rankings to yield an overall score. Players must receive at least 2 votes to be selected.
 - e. Players will be ranked in order based on their overall score (lowest to highest).
 - f. Players with the lowest overall scores will be selected to the All-Star Team.
 - g. Tiebreakers for last position(s):
 - 1) Playing Age (i.e. – a 10 yr old will be selected over a 9 yr old)
 - 2) Number of total votes received
 - 3) Highest ranking single vote
 - 4) Re-vote by all division head coaches for all kids tied only (Sections 4.c.-f.).
 - 5) All-Star Head Coach and a representative from EPR will make a decision.
 - h. Selections are limited to the following:
 - 1) Baseball/Softball – 12 players (3 alternates)
 - 2) Basketball – 10 players (2 alternates)* Alternates may practice with the team, but will only play in games if any of the non-alternate players cannot participate.
